If the number of entries received on the day of deadline exceeds the maximum number for any event, the lowest ranked entries will be returned. Entries from international clubs or associations will not be returned. In men's single 8-16 players will be seeded directly to play-off, In women's single 4-8 players will be seeded directly to play-off. In all group events number one and two is qualified for play-off. Men's single starts Saturday evening with qualifications round of groups (4 players).

LIMITATIONS

Thursday a player can play in one team
Friday a player can play in one event
Saturday a player can play in maximum 3 events
Sunday a player can play in one event.

SEEDING

Seedings for the the Men's and Women's Open Singles will be determined first according to the ITTF World Ranking Top 300, then according to the current Swedish ranking. Seeding for other events will be determined according to the current Swedish ranking. However, international players may be seeded, after consideration by Swedish national team captain and high-performance director.

PRICE MONEY

Sweden Tour uses the policy of equal price money for men and women. A total of SEK 40,000 will be awarded in the Open events and SEK 24,000 in the Youth 20 and 17 events.
